- 2. Unzip files and download them to your computer. NOTE: The Files will download to your "Downloads" folder.
- 3. Open and complete the Modules in the order they appear. Play in Slide Show mode. If you require closed captions, use Presenter View. To play weblinks or "Action Buttons," right click on the slide to stop the Slide Show then click on the link or action button. When the video link is done, click on the slide to restart the presentation (you can also click on the SLIDE SHOW tab then select to play "from current slide).
